Creating the reality of our Vision through courage strikes me as one tremendous way of say thank you for all our blessings.

that are assisted through the programs and services of our Foundation.

**Mention** - that the seller of each winning Sweepstakes ticket can also a winner (the back of the winning ticket

must be completed) and that SWEEPS tickets will sell if they are made visible.

Mention that if a Club member sells at least 25 complete books of Sweepstakes tickets and complies with the requirements for an Individual Seller Prize winner, they may become a winner.

**Distribute** - Sweepstakes tickets to Club members at your January meeting.

Members not present at this meeting, should also receive Sweepstakes tickets.

**Continue** - to promote Sweepstakes sales through your Club's April meeting. Additional tickets are available from our LIF by contacting Joanne (contact information is below). If your Club does not participate in Sweepstakes, possibly they would consider purchasing the Club's Sweepstakes tickets by donating to the current Sweepstakes campaign.

The Sight and Sound Sweepstakes program is our Lions of Illinois Foundation's second largest fundraiser, let's support this campaign and make this year the best we have ever had. If you do not receive your tickets prior to your first January Club meeting (after Christmas), contact Joanne at our Lions of Illinois Foundation (800 955-5466). Due to legal reasons, tickets are not sent to Leo Clubs.

For additional information on the 2012 Sweepstakes campaign contact your District Sweepstakes coordinator or either of your District Trustees (see your District Directory for telephone numbers).

**Appoint** - an enthusiastic Lion and/or Lioness as your Club Sight & Sound Sweepstakes Chairperson. This should be a person who can take charge of the project, communicate with Club members, and maintain Sweepstakes activity throughout the campaign. The campaign starts in January and is completed with the drawing during the Foundation Breakfast at the State convention in May.

**Study** - the 'How To' manual (a copy is enclosed with your first batch of tickets) and the 'Individual Seller Prize' form. Both the Club President and Sweepstakes Chairperson should understand how and why our Lions of Illinois Foundation (LIF) conducts this annual Sweepstakes campaign.

**Explain** - the Sweepstakes program and how it relates to our LIF and to your Club members. Explain that our LIF is part of our Lions of Illinois and is not part of Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF). Explain how your Club can benefit by scheduling the activities and programs of LIF to your Club members. Members should be made aware of these programs through information presented during Club meetings and in your Club's newsletters, especially during the months of January through May.

**Illustrate** - to your Club how this is an excellent no cost fundraising project for your Club's eye and hearing related projects. Additionally, this is our LIF's second largest fundraiser, with the real winners being those individuals

# Lions of Illinois Foundation Diabetes Awareness Campaign Fact Sheet

## What is the Lions of Illinois Foundation Diabetes Campaign?

The Lions of Illinois Foundation Awareness Campaign is an event conducted in a similar manner to Lions Candy Day. Lion members will be stationed at the entrances to shopping malls, grocery stores, etc. to distribute diabetes risk tests, sugar-free candies and accept donations. In the past ten years, over \$750,000 has been raised for diabetes research and programs. Over one million citizens have been reached with the vital message of the risk factors and seriousness of diabetes.

## Why is the Awareness Campaign Important?

The Lions of Illinois Foundation is to accomplish the following:

- Identify and alert individuals at high risk for developing diabetes which include blindness, stroke, heart disease, kidney disease and amputation.
- Provide free diabetic retinopathy exams to prevent blindness.
- Fund diabetes research to find a cure for diabetes and improved methods of treating diabetic retinopathy which is the leading cause of new cases of blindness in adults.

## How Can Clubs Participate?

A letter and registration form is sent to all Lions and Lioness Clubs in Illinois. The letter and form provide details about the program. The Club Coordinator for the Diabetes Awareness Campaign completes the form and returns it to Lions of Illinois Foundation. The LIF will acknowledge receipt of the form and supply all materials needed for the campaign. The materials include labels for collection buckets, risk tests, sugar-free candies, report forms and return envelopes. All materials are imprinted with the name and logo of the Lions of Illinois Foundation. At the conclusion of the campaign, clubs remit a check for the amount collected made payable to the Lions of Illinois Foundation with the campaign report form. Please in the memo part of your check write: Diabetes Awareness Campaign

## When Would The Program Be Conducted?

Clubs may choose any date between March 1<sup>st</sup> and May 31<sup>st</sup>. While it is preferred this time frame be followed, exceptions can be made if circumstances prevent the campaign from being conducted during that time.

## How Are The Funds Raised Distributed?

All funds raised are used to provide programs and services for the citizens of Illinois and to support research. The Lions of Illinois Foundation receives 100% of the proceeds; which will then be determined as to how to distribute according to amount collected.

## Let them eat (sugar-free) cake

For over half a century the Lions of Illinois has been proud to sponsor Camp Lions of Illinois for the Blind & Deaf. Camp Lions offers sessions for both youth & adults who have visual &/or hearing impairments. Camp Lions & Camp Helen Keller are safe environments for campers to be with their peers, take on new challenges, & make friendships to last a lifetime.

Eligible youth attending Camp Lions of Illinois, ages 7 to 17 years old, enjoy activities that are often not open to them in their own communities simply because they have a hearing or vision loss. At Camp Lions kids are encouraged to expand their self-confidence. This positive attitude can be seen everywhere & everyday at Camp Lions.

Adults, age 18 & older, who are Blind and/or Deaf may attend Helen Keller Camp. Here campers are encouraged to take part in a wide variety of events. It may be painting, a stroll through the woods, a game of beeper-ball, an afternoon swim, riding a horse, & more. What may seem to be fun and games actually give campers a chance to be with peers who have the similar abilities. Here they are not the only person who is different, but are part of the majority. A large percent of adults look forward to Camp Helen Keller as the one week a year they are not alone at home or in a residential facility.

Camp Lions is a life experience unique to each camper. Some meet another blind or deaf camper their own age & are inspired to realize they are not alone. Perhaps a new activity discovered at Camp is one they can take home to enjoy day after day.

To make these camps possible we need your help. We are asking that each club help sponsor one camper, or more if possible, to enjoy this enriching experience.

A \$525 donation to adopt a camper is a small investment for the memories, friends, & self-confidence gained changing a camper's life forever.

While this amount does not cover the full expense of the program (nearly \$950 per camper), when combined with other donations made to these programs, it helps to provide the needed funds. We hope that Clubs do not restrict their donation to only children & adults in their immediate service area, but remember that the entire state of Illinois relies on your open heart.
